



We hope you enjoyed our 2011 Connecting Flowers embroidery BOM program. Last year we concentrated on a variety of appliqué techniques. This year we will be helping you to expand your knowledge and understanding of different types of fabrics and textures when working with embroidery. Farm Life is a fun project that can be made into a lap quilt, wall hanging or soft story book for your favorite farmer.

Classes **meet the 4th Saturday of the month at 9:15**, before the shop opens. Each month there will be a lecture and demo to prepare you for this month's block. The project includes embroidered and pieced blocks. We will teach you how to create pieced blocks in the hoop or you can create them

Registration is \$55/per person and covers the cost of the embroidery design card needed to complete the project. Each month you will get a new embroidered and two pieced blocks to complete with the fabric and directions for each. If you can't make one of the classes just let us know and we will save your kit for future pick-up.

We will continue to have our "oops" bucket available should you need a small piece of fabric to correct a mistake in a block. You may also purchase your own oops kits with a piece of each fabric used in the kit for creating a matching project or for those just in case moments.



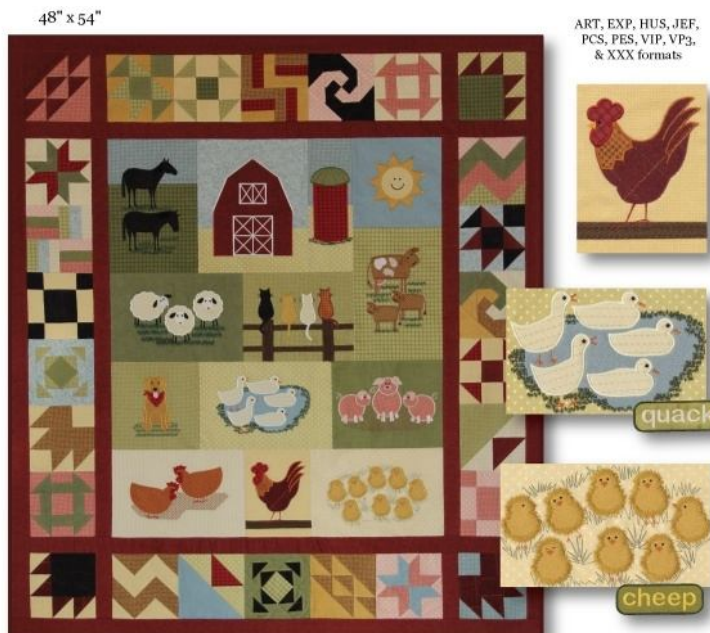

The program starts in January on the 28th at 9:15. Registration is \$55 and the 12-months of kits are \$5 a month and include the specialty fabrics and embellishments as called for by the blocks.
